Instructions

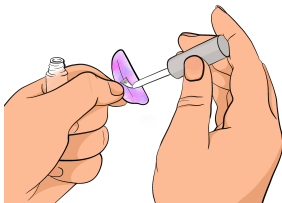
Step 1

Secure the lower lashes with pads or tape of your choice.



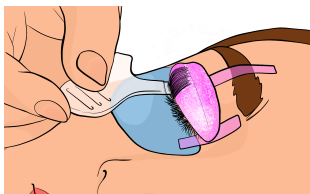
Step 2

Adhere the rods/shields/curlers to the eyelid using a lash lift adhesive.



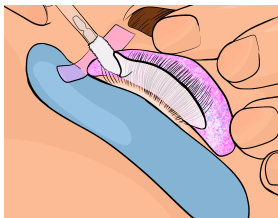
Step 3

Adhere the lashes to the rods/shields/curlers. The lashes must point in the correct direction, and not cross each other.



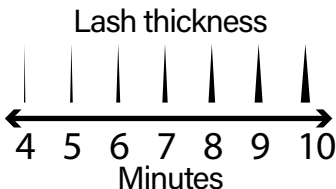
Step 4

Apply the eyelash perming lotion from the roots and halfway up the rods/shields/curlers. Create a sharp edge where the lotion ends for a uniform result.



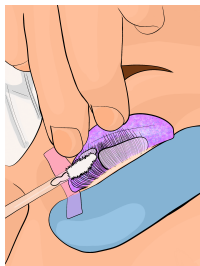
Step 5

Let the perming lotion work for 7 minutes. If the lashes are thinner than normal you should reduce the time slightly. If the lashes are thicker and stronger you may extend it slightly.



Step 6

Remove as much of the perming lotion as possible. We recommend using a thick microbrush or applicator wand to scrape it off.



Step 7

Double check that the lashes are pointing in the correct direction, and adjust if necessary. Then apply the eyelash neutralizing lotion. Make sure to cover the entire area which was affected by the eyelash perming lotion. We recommend applying the lotion in an upwards motion as to not move the lashes out of place. Let the neutralizing lotion work for 5 minutes.

Step 8

Remove the neutralizing lotion. We recommend using a thick microbrush or applicator wand. Then wash away any adhesive and remove the rods/shields/curlers with water or lash shampoo.

Let the lashes dry to see the full effect.

Precautions for use

Applies to both **NORLASH Eyelash Perming Lotion** and **NORLASH Eyelash Neutralizing Lotion**.

Avoid contact with eyes. Rinse eyes immediately if a product comes into contact with them. Wear suitable gloves. For professional use only. Follow the instructions. Store in a cool place, not above room temperature.

NORLASH Eyelash Perming Lotion contains thioglycolate. NORLASH Eyelash Neutralizing Lotion contains hydrogen peroxide.
